## RHB-The Star Mighty Minds National Challenge 2011

KUALA LUMPUR - RHB—The Star Mighty Minds National Challenge 2011 ended on a high note at Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC), Kuala Lumpur here today.

The Grand Finals was graced by Yang Berhormat Datuk Haji Fadillah Yusof, Deputy Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI). Also present were Mr. Kellee Kam, Managing Director of RHB Capital Berhad and Mr. Ho Kay Tat, Group Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Star Publications (M) Berhad.

The preliminary rounds of the Mighty Minds National Challenge competition kicked off on 2nd April 2011 where a total of 1,654 teams from various states throughout Malaysia participated. Today, the State Champions comprising 14 teams in the lower and upper secondary categories competed to vie for the coveted title. Into its third year, the competition showcased and tested students' skills, knowledge and their ability to put theory into practice.

The **Mighty Minds Grand Finals** was a two-day event in which all 14 state qualifying teams competed in the quiz rounds and hands-on challenge in their respective categories (primary and secondary). The best five teams, based on the highest score (in both quizzes and hands-on challenge), were selected for a 5-minute presentation in the hands-on challenge.

# **Brief on Mighty Minds National Challenge**

The first Mighty Minds challenge in 2011 took place in Malacca on 2nd April. The competition continued over several months in various states in Peninsula Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak, until July 2011. This year, overwhelming response was received in Selangor and Kuala Lumpur, where the competition saw an increase of 23% and 22% in participation respectively. In total, 807 teams participated in the lower secondary category (F123), while 847 teams took part in the upper secondary category (F4F5) in the state challenges.
