RHB ART WITH HEART 2023 SHINES THE SPOTLIGHT ON MALAYSIA’S YOUNG AND EMERGING ARTISTS

Kuala Lumpur – RHB Art with Heart 2023 annual exhibition by the RHB Banking Group returned for the fifth year with the theme ‘Sparks of Change’ to showcase and celebrate the creativity and diversity of Malaysia’s young and emerging artists.
